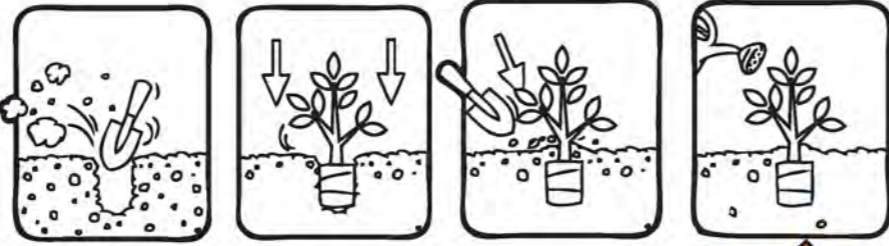


PAPER HAS A GREAT STORY

Cereal boxes, milk cartons, labels and loo paper. Oh, and printing and writing paper too!

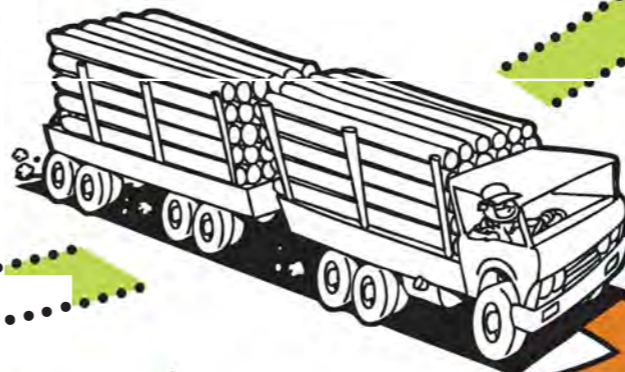

Paper recycling mill

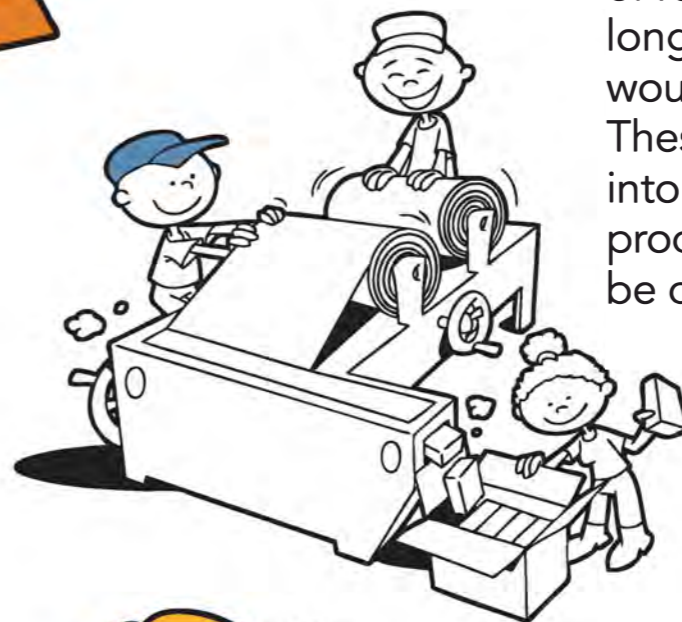

At the paper mill, logs are chipped and made into a soupy pulp.

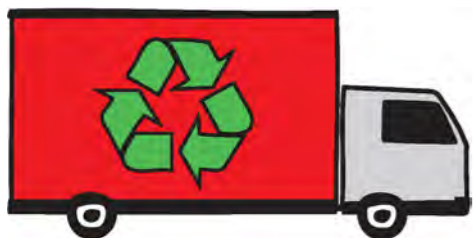

The pulp is poured onto paper machines and fed through a series of rollers to dry it. The long sheets of paper are wound onto large reels. These are then made into different paper products. Pulp can also be dried and sold as sheets. Special pulp can be used to make things like viscose fabric!
